

Contract for Services
Private Piano Lessons
CALVARY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL
2007/2008

Private piano lessons will be supplied at Calvary Christian School by professional music educators at a rate of **\$ 585/year which is \$ 65 per month per child (September through May)**, payable to Calvary Christian School. Payment is due in advance by the first of each month. A late fee of \$ 25 will be assessed to your account if payment is not paid by the 10th. **You may add music to your automatic draft**, which would avoid any late fee assessment. If you pay by check, please specify on the check that the payment is for music lessons. *No statements will be sent out to remind you.* Late fees are assessed on the 15th of each month and statements reflecting late fees are mailed out on the 16th. *Registration fee is \$ 20 per child.* After determining the appropriate level to begin the child's lessons this year, the piano teacher will select the music which each student will need and will purchase the music. The teacher is reimbursed personally for the music.

Withdrawal policy: If your child quits/withdraws in the middle of the month, no refund will be issued because we still have to pay the music teacher for the number of students for the month. If you paid music lessons in full for the year, you will receive a refund for unused months.

Private lessons will begin the week of August 21st. This contract signed by all parties must be submitted by the first scheduled lesson. Only students with signed contracts will be allowed to begin private piano/voice lessons at CCS. Students will receive *thirty-two private lessons* during the course of the year with the following provisions:

1. Lessons will be weekly thirty minute sessions.
2. Every effort will be made to schedule lessons during the enrichment classes of the child.
3. Should a lesson be missed due to the illness of the student or absence of the piano/voice teacher, every effort will be made to reschedule.
4. Because contracted teachers are only at the school two/three days of the week and have full schedules, any lesson missed by the student for any reason other than the aforementioned will not be rescheduled and will be forfeited. Some examples of forfeited lessons are:
 - a. Student fails to bring a signed contract.
 - b. Student who forgets to come to a lesson.
 - c. Student who forgets lesson books at home.
 - d. Student who is not in school for any reason except illness.
 - e. Student who is not prepared for lesson.
 - f. Absences due to school field trips.

Music develops responsibility because it is a subject requiring discipline and diligent practice. Because music is an applied study, students will be required to practice daily. Failure to practice consistently will result in the cancellation of private lessons at CCS. Parents, teacher and student must work together to insure the success of the student in the study of the discipline of music and in preparation for and attendance of lessons.

I understand and agree to the terms of the contract for services of private piano lessons at CCS. I will abide by the terms of this contract for the 2007-2008 school year.
