



Drama Teacher Full-Time

Job Description

Calvary Christian School seeks a talented and energetic professional to develop and lead its drama program for the Academy and Upper School (includes grades 5-12) 2025-2026 school year. The ideal candidate will need extensive experience in teaching drama classes and planning and leading drama productions. They must have strong organizational and communication skills. The candidate will be a devoted follower of Jesus Christ, committed to Christ-centered teaching and to Calvary's mission: "Teaching the Whole Child the Whole Truth." This position reports to the Fine Arts Director.

Essential Job Functions:

- Instructs all drama classes (5th-12th grade) such that students develop acting skills with enthusiasm and enjoyment
- Plans and leads designated drama performances and trips
- Assists in the planning and performance of the upper school one-act, middle school one-act, and the spring musical
- Collaborates with colleagues in the Fine Arts Department
- Maintains active membership in drama-related associations
- Integrates a Christian worldview with all elements of theater
- Facilitate the thespian troupe
- Maintain costumes, props, and stage equipment

Responsibilities:

- Engages in regular professional development
- Models and instructs good acting techniques appropriate for each developmental age

- Uses knowledge of child development at each level of instruction
- Helps students gain confidence and improve in performance
- Actively recruits student participants
- Collaborates with the administration in planning for performances and designated community events
- Demonstrates strong organizational and communication abilities
- Demonstrates excellent interpersonal and collaborative skills
- Selects students to represent Calvary Christian School in drama competitions such as the GISA Region and State Literary Competitions
- Maintains the Upper School drama budget and oversees related purchases
- Develops and maintains student performance requirements
- Supports and assists drama instruction and performance in the Lower School
- Completes other duties as assigned
